



Dear Prospective Beneficiary,

For almost 80 years the Calvert Garden Club has contributed to our community in many ways, including the award of financial grants since 2013. The theme of our 2023 grant and all proposed projects shall be: “**CREATE.**”

In order to become a qualified applicant, all the following requirements must be met:

- Applicant organization must be a charitable or non-profit organization with a 501(c)(3) status or an EIN
- Applicant organization must be domiciled in Calvert County, Maryland
- Proposed project must help protect natural resources and encourage conservation practices in Calvert County, Maryland
- Submit completed grant application – 2 pages
- All grant funds must be used for the proposed project. The Calvert Garden Club will conduct a follow-up visit after award of the grant.
- Successful grantee is required to provide a report to the Calvert Garden Club no later than December 31, 2022, describing how the grant funds were used and the status of the project. The report may be emailed or mailed to the addresses indicated in the application submittal instructions.
